



The **Capital Bicycle Racing Club** is the New York Capital Region's premier bicycle racing club. Its mission, as its name implies, is to promote and develop the sport of bicycle racing in the Capital District. CBRC is a chartered club of USA Cycling, the official cycling organization recognized by the US Olympic Committee.

CBRC has been in existence for over 25 years and retains an annual membership of more than 100 riders. Club members are committed cyclists who compete in bicycle racing in the Capital District and throughout the New England and Mid-Atlantic regions. CBRC Team Members make approximately 500 appearances at bicycle races annually.

CBRC members range in age from 10 years to 80+ years of age, and include students and professionals, men and women.

The club organizes spinning classes during the winter months and offers these classes at little or no cost to club members.
