- Bring a marshal, race for free



Registration:

- Pre-Registration at www.BikeReg.com by 5:00 PM the Friday before the race.
- Day-of registration may be available space permitting for \$40 (*ouch*), please pre-register!
- Number pickup opens at 9:30 AM and continues until ½ hour before each race
- One-day and annual licenses are available for \$10 and \$60, respectively.

Mixed Fields: including men, women, juniors & masters. Race may not qualify for upgrade points.

Wheel Vehicles: Wheel-in/Wheels-out. Neutral if 8 sets provided per field.

Rules:

- All USAC Rules Apply (no Aero-Bars, sleeveless jerseys), approved helmets, etc.
- All Juniors - gearing restrictions apply. Rollout at school registration area.

Weather Cancellation?

In the event of severe weather (snow, ice, etc.) race will be cancelled and announced on BikeReg by 7:00 AM the morning of the race. An email will be sent to all pre-registered. No Refunds due to weather or circumstances beyond the control of the promoter— you will receive a credit to a future race.

Directions to Cocksackie-Athens High School

GPS	26 Sunset Boulevard Cocksackie, NY 12051
From the South	I-87 (NYS Thruway) North to Exit 21B. Turn south on Route 9W, continue 2 miles until second traffic light. Turn left onto Route 385 (Mansion Street). Bear right onto Route 385 (Washington Ave). Turn right onto Sunset Blvd (1.8 miles from start of Route 385 to Sunset Blvd.). High School is on the right.
From the North	87 (NYS Thruway) North to Exit 21B. Follow directions above from South.
From Mass Pike	Take Mass Pike west to New York - NYS Thruway Berkshire Spur. Continue west over the Hudson River for 10 miles to I-87. Take I-87 south one exit to Exit 21B. Follow directions above from South.
From Taconic	Continue north until the parkway ends on the NYS Thruway Berkshire Spur. Follow directions above from Mass Pike.
